

Connecting to Cloudflare WARP instructions

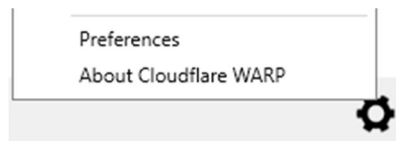
The following instruction is designed to guide the user through the process of connecting to Cloudflare Zero Trust network in order to access certain Company's resources internally. Please disregard these instructions if you are not connected to the Company's network as you need to use another application.

- a. Download and install the latest version of WARP through Cloudflare.

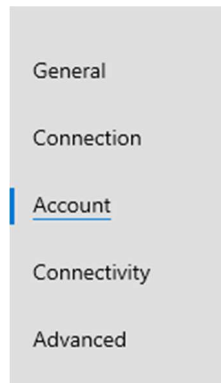

- b. Open the Cloudflare WARP application. Click the gear icon in the bottom right and choose "Preferences."



- c. Select the "Account" tab from the menu.



- d. Select "Login with Cloudflare Zero Trust."

Login with Cloudflare Zero Trust

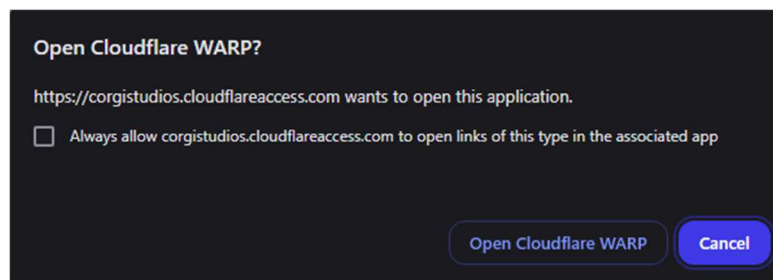
- e. When prompted, enter `corgistudios.cloudflareaccess.com` as the team name.

- f. A page will open on your browser. Follow instructions through Cloudflare Access to connect your Azure AD (Microsoft) account with Cloudflare WARP. Please note that only emails ending in `@corgistudios.tech` are permitted to connect.
- g. Choose “Open Cloudflare WARP” through the banner pop-up.



- h. Connect to the Zero Trust. You are able to access Company’s resources through the Portal, <https://portal.corgistudios.tech/>.
